# STERLING HARBOR DUKE OF FLUKE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Contestants must be registered and entry fee of \$250.00 paid to Sterling Harbor before 7:00 AM on July 12, 2008. One (1) T-Shirt is included with entry fee. Four (4) dinner tickets are included with entry fee. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased for \$20.00.
2. The Tournament Director reserve the right to decline the entry of any boat or angler(s) for any reason whatsoever.
3. Registration on or before July 5, 2008 makes you eligible for the drawing for one FREE "Duke of Fluke" 2009 entry valued at \$250.00.
4. All fishing and boating rules, regulations and licensing in effect shall apply and be adhered to by all participants. It is the participants responsibility to know the rules and regulations of the State and body of water being fished. All contestants are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, and safety.
5. All fish must be caught on a rod and reel.
6. There is a limit of four (4) lines allowed in the water at one time, regardless of the number of anglers on the boat. This means no more than four anglers per boat fishing at one time.
7. All boats must check in at the Intercoastal Waterway in front of Shawcrest Marina or at Sterling Harbor Marina at 7:30 AM the day of the tournament for a shotgun start. Assigned boat number cards must be displayed on the vessel in a manner that shall allow it to be seen from a distance and must remain in place throughout the tournament.
8. Contestants may fish any area including the Atlantic Ocean, Delaware Bay, and back waters.
9. There are no weather make up days unless Tournament fishing is cancelled by the Tournament Director. The tournament is captain and crew choice as for fishable weather conditions.
10. At no time is any boat permitted to approach another boat, structure or land. Verified emergencies are excepted.
11. Weigh-in will begin at 4:00 PM. No fish will be accepted for weigh-in prior to 4:00 PM. All contestants must have their fish available for weigh-in at Sterling Harbor no later than 5:00 PM. All boats must weigh-in their own fish. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
12. All Fluke entered for Single Heaviest Category must be weighed in alive. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
13. Fluke entered for Single Heaviest Category may not be entered for Combined Weight Category.
14. Fluke entered for Combined Weight Category may include fish caught by all contestants from each boat; total of five (5) fish.
15. Fish being entered in the Junior Angler Category and the Duchess Category may be entered into the Single Heaviest Category or the Combined Weight Category and must be weighed-in by the angler who caught the fish.
16. Any participants attempting to weigh-in an illegal size fish into any category will be disqualified from the tournament, forfeit their entry fee, and be ineligible for any prizes.
17. All fish will be subject to examinations externally and/or internally, or as any judge deems necessary. It shall be the responsibility of the participant to keep all eligible fish in suitable and proper condition until weigh-in.
18. Any participants attempting to weigh-in a fish deemed by the judge(s) to be shot, speared, gill-netted, gaffed, frozen, mutilated, altered in any way, or of questionable freshness, will be disqualified from the tournament, forfeit their entry fee, and be ineligible for any prizes. In other words folks, do not bring such a fish to the scale. In the event of any disputes arising from such examination, the decision of the judge(s) shall be final and not subject to appeal.
19. Any participant caught breaking the rules or caught cheating in any way will be disqualified from this tournament, forfeit their entry fee, be ineligible for any prizes, and prohibited from entering any future tournaments held by Sterling Harbor.
20. It is the intention of Sterling Harbor to conduct a fair, honest, and professional tournament. Common sense and "spirit of the rule" shall apply at all times. Rules interpretation is exclusively left to the Tournament Director. The decisions of the Tournament Director are final in all matters and are not subject to appeal.
21. Any disputes or allegations of rule violations must be made in writing and delivered by the person making the allegation, with evidence, to the tournament director no later than fifteen minutes after the final fish is weighed-in. In all cases, contestants agree to be bound by the ruling of the Tournament Director.
22. **Hold Harmless Agreement** - As a participant in the 2008 Duke of Fluke Tournament and knowing the risks and dangers of what may develop in such activities, I agree to hold harmless and discharge the sponsors, namely Sterling Harbor Bait & Tackle, their assigns, agents, employees, and all others in any way associated with this tournament, against any and all claims, damages, demands, cost and/or expenses incurred by me or on my own behalf arising out of personal injury, property damage, acts of God and/or accident incurred by anyone while engaged in this contest.
